The abstract must be written in English and its extent is limited to one A4 page (25 mm margins). The title of the abstract should be typed using the 14 pt Times New Roman bold font. The names of the authors and their affiliations should be then typed with the 12 pt Times New Roman font using the regular and italic font style, respectively. The title, author names and their affiliations should be centered and mutually separated by one empty line. Please underline the name of the presenting/ corresponding author.




Fig. 1: Figure (and table) captions should be typed using the 11 pt Times New Roman font.

The body of the abstract is typed again using the 12 pt Times New Roman font. The text is justified. There is one empty line between the abstract body and the preceding part of the abstract. In the whole document single line spacing is applied. You may also include equations, tables, figures (see Fig. 1) and references [1]. If an equation is given, like Eq. (1),

$$\lambda = \pi r_0^2 c n_{\perp} \tag{1}$$

the Microsoft (MS) equation editor should be used.
